

# Parkanaur Forest

## Overview

Four miles west of Dungannon, Parkanaur Forest was formally part of the Burgess Estate. The woodland around this forest is made up of a mixture of conifer and broad-leaved woodland. There is also an enclosed herd of white fallow deer and a wildlife pond. Colourful in spring with daffodils and rhododendrons, the walking trails run through oak and beech trees, passing a Victorian garden, wishing well and archway.


